- Ending point and time: Auenhütte, around 4 p.m., Oberstdorf train station around 4:30 p.m.
- Level of difficulty: difficult

Vertical distance: Ascent ca. 1.000 m, descent ca. 1.000 m, possible short-cut by ski-lift.

From Oberstdorf train station, there will be a transfer to Auenhütte. We will arrange ourselves with the cars available. There is an ascent of about 3 hours, along Gottesackerplateau and through the Gottesackerwände. On the summit of Hoher Ifen there will be a solemn vigil, led
