WHAT'S ESC?

ESC – European Solidarity Corps is funded by Erasmus+ and it is a partnership between two promoting organisations. These organisations are responsible for recruiting volunteers for their project. Volunteers participate in ESC through a “Sending Organisation” in the country where they live and a “Receiving Organisation” that hosts them during their time of service. The project can last between 9 to 12 months, for example from September 2024 until September 2025, but we are flexible regarding the start and end date.

ESC AT CIPRA INTERNATIONAL

CIPRA is a non-profit umbrella organisation with offices in seven Alpine countries and a member network of over 100 associations. It is committed to the protection and the sustainable development in the Alps.

As a volunteer at CIPRA International in Liechtenstein you will work in the field of sustainable development in an international setting. You will support our communication work (Social Media, website, newsletter etc.) and our project managers in alpine wide projects.

You will live in Liechtenstein and receive free accommodation, insurance, pocket money for food and other expenses, bus ticket in Liechtenstein and support for the travel costs to and from Liechtenstein.

YOUR PROFILE

Since you will work in the field of sustainable development in the Alps, you should first and foremost be interested in this topic. We prefer if you already have some experiences in project work, such as volunteering for a local club. Very good knowledge of English and basic knowledge of German are required. German is our working language and we offer a German course to strengthen your language skills.
